

**CLASS D11, JEWELRY, SYMBOLIC INSIGNIA,
AND ORNAMENTS****SECTION I - CLASS DEFINITION**

This class provides for design patents claiming ornamental designs for:

1. Fastener, Buckle or Restraint for Apparel or Personal Belongings Not Elsewhere Specified
2. Jewelry
3. Symbolic Medal, Badge or Insignia
4. Artificial Plant Life and Holiday Season Decorations
5. Sculpture, Table or Wall Ornament
6. Flag or Pennant
7. Miscellaneous

- (1) Note. Design patents in this class are classified by what is claimed and shown in full lines only. Broken, hatched or stippled lines, which may be included in design patent drawings, are considered as environment only.

165 FLAG OR PENNANT:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for textile form used as a symbol or representation for a country, organization, or intelligence.

184 MISCELLANEOUS:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design relates to jewelry, symbolic insignia and ornaments not elsewhere provided for.

- (1) Note. Includes inedible cake or pastry decorations.
- (2) Note. Includes ornament or bow for package.

200 FASTENER, BUCKLE OR RESTRAINT FOR APPAREL OR PERSONAL BELONGINGS NOT ELSEWHERE SPECIFIED:

This subclass is indented under the class definition. Design for article to fasten or secure clothing or personal articles not elsewhere provided for.

- (1) Note. Subject matter in this subclass is distinguished from subject matter found in Class D2 in that it is directed to fasteners for wearing apparel. Subject matter classified in D2 is directed to fasteners that attach apparel to the body.
